



DROGHEDA SAIL TRAINING BURSARY SCHEME CRUISE ON *BRIAN BORÚ* (B91)

SUNDAY 10 JUNE 2018 – DROGHEDA PORT

1300	Trainees arrive on board. Family and friends welcome to come aboard to meet the crew, and see the Brian Ború
1330	Parents and friends ashore
1340	Light lunch
Afternoon	Assignment of bunks, stow luggage Allocation of Watches and Duties. (There will be two 'watches' of five trainees each. One watch is always on duty during daylight hours – operating the ship when at sea and on "harbour watch" or "anchor watch" duty when not at sea. Each trainee does a 24 hour 'tour of duty' in the galley (or kitchen), shopping, preparing meals, serving meals, cleaning up, ensuring snacks and drinks are kept going during the day.) Full Safety Briefing and Emergency Drills Learn the Ropes with the Crew Help the Captain prepare the Navigation Plan for the week. Galley trainees prepare dinner.
1815	Trainees and crew dine on board together
Night	Drogheda Port


MONDAY 11 JUNE 2018 – DROGHEDA TO HOWTH – 27 NAUTICAL MILES

0745	Breakfast on board
0830	Daily Briefing and prepare the <i>Brian Ború</i> for sea
0900	Depart Drogheda (HW Boyne Bar 1012)
1000	Exit the Boyne Estuary, sails up, engine off and feel the wind in your hair
1300	Anchor off Lambay Island for swim off the boat, followed by lunch. Opportunity to spot wildlife including Wallabies (small kangaroos) living on Lambay.
1430	"Make and Mend" – One hour every day where all on board clean and tidy the deck and living accommodation and, toilets on board boat as well conduct maintenance and any minor repairs on the boat, the rig and engine.
1530	Anchor aweigh, set the sails to go on the next stage of the voyage. Galley trainees prepare dinner.
1800	Arrive Howth



1815	Dinner on board
1930	Free time ashore – explore Howth or practice ropework and navigation with the captain and crew.
2100	All aboard for review of the day, relaxation and eventually to your bunk.
Night	Howth Harbour

TUESDAY 12 JUNE 2018 – HOWTH TO WICKLOW – 27 NAUTICAL MILES

0800	Breakfast on board
0900	Daily Briefing and prepare the <i>Brian Ború</i> for sea
0930	Depart Howth (HW Howth 1101)
0945	Sail past Ireland's Eye and turn south
1015	Sail past the Baily Lighthouse
	
1300	Lunch at sea
1400	Arrive Wicklow
1430	" <i>Make and Mend</i> " – 1 hour, followed by learning maritime skills.
1815	Dinner on board
1930	Free time ashore – explore Wicklow or practice ropework and navigation with the captain and crew, go fishing or use Brian Ború's dinghy
2100	All aboard for review of the day, relaxation and eventually to your bunk.
Night	Wicklow Harbour

WEDNESDAY 13 JUNE 2018 – WICKLOW TO DUN LAOGHAIRE – 21 NAUTICAL MILES

0715	Breakfast on board
0800	Daily Briefing and prepare the <i>Brian Ború</i> for sea
0830	Depart Wicklow (HW Wicklow 1138)
1200	Arrive Dun Laoghaire
1300	Lunch on board
1430	" <i>Make and Mend</i> " – 1 hour, followed by learning maritime skills.
1815	Dinner on board
1930	Free time ashore – explore Dun Laoghaire or practice ropework and navigation with the captain and crew, go fishing or use Brian Ború's dinghy
2100	All aboard for review of the day, relaxation and eventually to your bunk.
Night	Dun Laoghaire Harbour



THURSDAY 14 JUNE 2018 – DUN LAOGHAIRE TO MALAHIDE – 14 NAUTICAL MILES

0800	Breakfast on board
0900	Daily Briefing and prepare the <i>Brian Ború</i> for sea
0930	Depart Dun Laoghaire (HW 1252)
1130	Anchor off Ireland's Eye for a swim or use the dinghy
1230	Lunch on board
1315	" <i>Make and Mend</i> " – 1 hour
1415	Anchor aweigh and sail to Malahide
1500	Arrive Malahide (HW 1251) followed by learning maritime skills on board.
1815	Dinner on board
1930	Free time ashore – explore Malahide or practice ropework and navigation with the captain and crew, go fishing or use Brian Ború's dinghy
2100	All aboard for review of the day, relaxation and eventually to your bunk.
Night	Malahide Marina

FRIDAY 15 JUNE 2018 – MALAHIDE TO DROGHEDA – 26 NAUTICAL MILES

0330	Daily Briefing and prepare the <i>Brian Ború</i> for sea
0340	Depart Malahide Marina – sailing in the dark! (HW Malahide 0112, sunrise 0455)
0600	Anchor off Skerries and possibly an early morning swim
0730	Breakfast at anchor
0930	Anchor aweigh and depart under sail for Drogheda
1100	Cross River Boyne Bar (HW 1339)
1200	Parade of Sail into the IMF2018 (To be confirmed)



1300	Lunch on board
1400	Pack bags, tidy bunks
1500	Cruise debrief and last coffee/tea break on board <i>Brian Ború</i>
1600	Trainees disembark Brian Ború as <i>The Irish Maritime Festival</i> is setting up on Drogheda quays.
