SUNDAY 17 JUNE 2018 – DROGHEDA PORT

1300	Trainees arrive on board. Family and friends welcome to come aboard to meet the crew, and see the Brian Ború
1330	Parents and friends ashore
1340	Light lunch
Afternoon	Assignment of bunks, stow luggage Allocation of Watches and Duties. (There will be two 'watches' of five trainees each. One watch is always on duty during daylight hours – operating the ship when at sea and on "harbour watch" or "anchor watch" duty when not at sea. Each trainee does a 24 hour 'tour of duty' in the galley (or kitchen), shopping, preparing meals, serving meals, cleaning up, ensuring snacks and drinks are kept going during the day.) Full Safety Briefing and Emergency Drills Learn the Ropes with the Crew Help the Captain prepare the Navigation Plan for the week. Galley trainees prepare dinner.

MONDAY 18 JUNE 2018 – DROGHEDA TO WARRENPOINT – 32 NAUTICAL MILES


0800	Breakfast on board
0900	Daily Briefing and prepare the <i>Brian Ború</i> for sea
0930	Depart Drogheda (HW Boyne Bar 0340) ** depart time will change depending on weather **
1000	Exit the Boyne Estuary, sails up, engine off and feel the wind in your hair
1300	Lunch at sea
1600	Arrive Warrenpoint (HW 1615)
1700	" <i>Make and Mend</i> " – One hour every day where all on board clean and tidy the deck and living accommodation and, toilets on board boat as well conduct maintenance and any minor repairs on the boat, the rig and engine.
1815	Dinner on board

1930	Free time ashore – explore Warrenpoint or practice ropework and navigation with the captain and crew.	
2100	All aboard for review of the day, relaxation and eventually to your bunk.

TUESDAY 19 JUNE 2018 – WARRENPOINT TO ARDGLASS – 33 NAUTICAL MILES

0745	Breakfast on board
0830	Daily Briefing and prepare the <i>Brian Ború</i> for sea
0900	Depart Warrenpoint (HW 0420)
1300	Lunch at sea
1430	Arrive Ardglass followed by activities on board
1700	<i>“Make and Mend”</i> – 1 hour
1815	Dinner on board
1930	Free time ashore – explore Ardglass or practice ropework and navigation with the captain and crew, go fishing or use Brian Ború’s dinghy
2100	All aboard for review of the day, relaxation and eventually to your bunk.
Night	Ardglass

WEDNESDAY 20 JUNE 2018 – ARDGLASS TO PORTAFERRY – 10 NAUTICAL MILES

0830	Breakfast on board followed by activities on board and ashore	
1130	Daily Briefing and prepare the <i>Brian Ború</i> for sea	
1200	Depart Ardglass (HW 1755)	
1330	Arrive Portaferry	
1400	Lunch on board followed by activities on board and ashore	
1700	<i>“Make and Mend”</i> – 1 hour, followed by learning maritime skills.	
1815	Dinner on board	
1930	Free time ashore – explore Portaferry or practice ropework and navigation with the captain and crew, go fishing or use Brian Ború’s dinghy	
2100	All aboard for review of the day, relaxation and eventually to your bunk.

THURSDAY 21 JUNE 2018 – PORTAFERRY TO KILKEEL – 29 NAUTICAL MILES

0630	Breakfast on board
0715	Daily Briefing and prepare the <i>Brian Ború</i> for sea
0745	Depart Portaferry (HW 0753)
1235	Anchor off Kilkeel for a swim or use the dinghy
1300	Lunch on board and then anchor aweigh and motor into Kilkeel
1430	Berth at Kilkeel followed by activities on board and ashore
1700	" <i>Make and Mend</i> " – 1 hour
1815	Dinner on board
1930	Free time ashore – explore Kilkeel or practice ropework and navigation with the captain and crew, go fishing or use Brian Ború's dinghy
2100	All aboard for review of the day, relaxation and eventually to your bunk.
Night	Kilkeel

FRIDAY 22 JUNE 2018 – KILKEEL TO DROGHEDA – 27 NAUTICAL MILES

0530	Daily Briefing and prepare the <i>Brian Ború</i> for sea
0600	Depart Kilkeel (HW 0737)
0940	Cross Boyne Bar and into River Boyne
1040	Arrive Drogheda (HW Boyne Bar 0738)
1130	" <i>Make and Mend</i> " – 1 hour
1300	Lunch on board
1400	Pack bags, tidy bunks
1500	Cruise debrief and last coffee/tea break on board <i>Brian Ború</i>
1600	All trainees disembark <i>Brian Ború</i>
